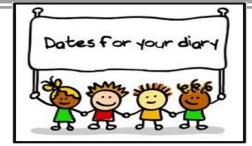
Please ensure your child is coming on time to Nursery as they are missing their learning time. Please see below a reminder of Nursery opening times.
