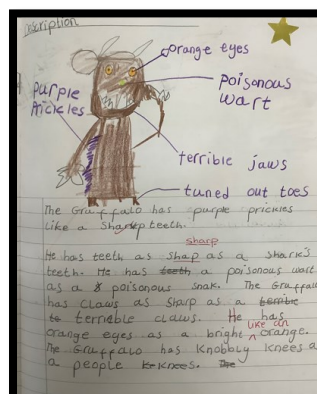
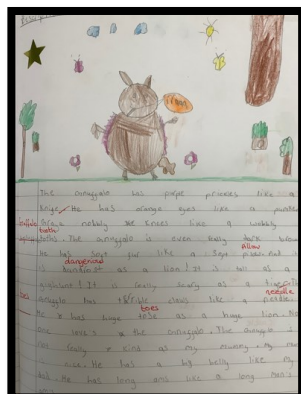
Year 3 Geography

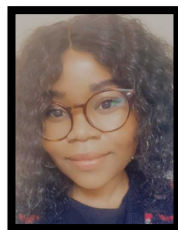
Attendance Winners:
