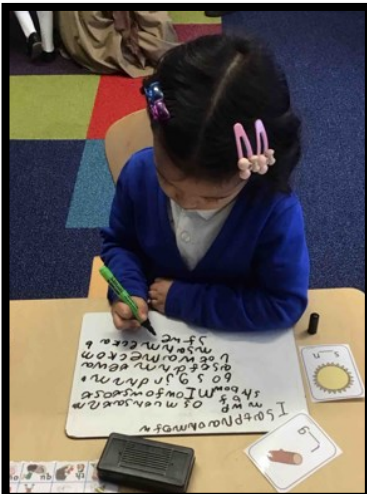
I wanted to congratulate the Year 6 pupils on completing their SATs this week. Without exception, the pupils have shown a really positive attitude and resilience in all the papers.

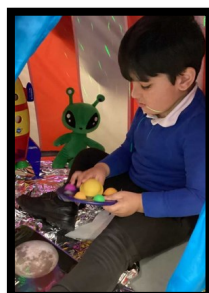
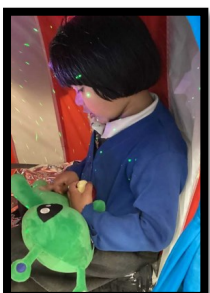
Attendance Winners:
